## Biowaste

- biowaste bin in the backyard
- biowaste bin shared with your neighbours
- composter

## Bulky waste and renovation materials

- waste station (jäteasema), waste centre (jätekeskus)
- Repsikka pickup service

## Carton packaging

- sorting bin in the backyard
- sorting bin shared with your neighbours
- recycling point (ekopiste)
- waste station, waste centre

## Electronic equipment

- waste station, waste centre
- Repe & Romu & Riepu collection round
- Repsikka pickup service

## End-of-life textiles

- Repe & Romu & Riepu collection round
- Nextiili store, Sokos and Stockmann shopping centres in Tampere
- Ideapark shopping center in Lempäälä

## Metal

- sorting bin in the backyard

- recycling point

## Mixed waste

- waste bin in the backyard
- waste bin shared with your neighbours
- regional waste collection point (only to the customers paying the annual payment)
- waste station, waste centre

## Paper

- sorting bin in the backyard
- sorting bin shared with your neighbours
- recycling point
- waste station, waste centre

## Plastic packaging

- sorting bin in the backyard
- sorting bin shared with your neighbours
- recycling point

## Twigs

- waste centre

## Reusable items

For example

- Textiles and shoes
- Furniture
- Books
- Sporting goods
- Tableware

**Sell** or **donate** for example in flea markets or through web.

**Take** clean and dry worn out clothes and textiles to collection.

Your trash could be someone else's treasure.



## Biowaste

For example

- Food leftovers
- Gutting remains and peelings
- Coffee filters and tea bags
- Paper towels and serviettes
- Flowers, grass and leaves
- Rotten groceries

**Drain** liquids from biowaste into drains, but not fats.

**Pack** biowaste in a newspaper or in a bio-decomposable bag.

Biowaste is turned into biogas and fertilizers.



## Paper

For example

- Newspapers and magazines
- Flyers
- Envelopes
- Copying paper and printing paper
- Catalogues

**Keep** the papers separate, don't tie them.

**No** cardboard.

**No** dirty or wet paper.

Paper is recycled into tissue paper or newspaper.



## Mixed waste

For example

- Dirty plastic packages and other plastic
- Dirty paper and cardboard
- Diapers and sanitary napkins
- Porcelain, ceramics
- Textiles, leather, rubber
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Light and halogen bulbs
- Cosmetics
- Ash and cigarette stubs
- Cassettes, CDs and DVDs
- Pet waste

Mixed waste is used for heating and electricity in Tammervoima waste-to-energy plant.



## Metals

**Small metal articles and packages**

- Non-deposit-based cans
- Aluminum pans and foils
- Pots and pans
- Cutlery
- Empty paint tins
- Empty, non-pressurised spray cans

**No** gas cylinders.

**Take** large metal objects to waste stations, waste centres or Repe&Romu collection round.

Metal is recycled into industrial raw material.



## Glass packaging

For example

- Glass jars
- Glass bottles

**No** porcelain, ceramics, glassware, bulbs, mirrors or sheet glass.

**Remove** the caps and lids.

It is not necessary to remove labels and bottle neck rings.

Glass is recycled into manufacturing of packaging glass.



## Carton packaging

For example

- Milk and juice cartons
- Boxes of cereal and cookies
- Hamburger and pizza boxes
- Disposable tableware made of cardboard
- Paper bags
- Paper tubes and egg cartons
- Wrapping paper and paperboard boxes
- Wrapping cardboard of drinks

**Rinse quickly with cold water and drain** cartons, **flatten and pack** inside one another.

**No** dirty and wet carton.

Cardboard is recycled into industrial raw material.



## Plastic packaging

**Only empty, clean and dry plastic**

For example

- Plastic food packaging
- Plastic carrier bags and wrappings
- Plastic bottles, cans and jars

**No** other plastic products such as toys, dishes, buckets etc.

Clean plastic to recycling, dirty to energy.



## Hazardous waste

For example

- Paints, glues and varnishes
- Solvents and diluents
- Chemicals with danger property
- Waste oil, oil filters and accumulators
- Fluorescent lamps and energy saving bulbs

**Store** waste in their original packaging.

**Take** medicines to the pharmacy.

Batteries and cell phone batteries are received at stores selling the new ones

**Take** hazardous waste to the waste station, waste centre or **Repe & Romu** collection round.

Hazardous waste is channelled to safe treatment.



## Electric equipment

For example

- Televisions, radios, mobile phones
- Computer equipment
- Fridges and freezers
- Ovens and microwaves
- Washing machines
- Vacuum cleaners
- Small devices

**Take** electric equipment to the waste station, waste centre or Repe&Romu collection round.

**Ask** receiving also at stores selling the new ones.

Materials are recycled.



## Twigs and gardening waste

For example

- Twigs
- Leaves and branches
- Apples
- Weeds and grass

**Don't mix** twigs with other gardening waste.

**Take** to waste centre in Koukkujärvi or Tarastenjärvi.

**Take** to waste centre in Koukkujärvi or Tarastenjärvi.

Twigs are chipped into the compost and gardening waste is composted.



## Bulky waste and renovation materials

For example

- Furniture, mattresses
- Stone materials, porcelain and tiles
- Insulation, flooring materials
- Timber

**Take your waste yourself** to the waste station or waste centre. The waste is processed before Tammervoima waste-to-energy plant.

**Collect** the load so that it is easy to unload and sort in reception. You will save time and money.

Energy usable waste is channelled to Tammervoima. The waste which is not usable for energy, is deposited to the landfill.
